Numbers were down - possibly due to the early start to the growing season and resulting early dormancy of both nectar and host plants and the summer drought.

In addition, two participants brought in 4 monarchs they reared at home, which were tagged and released at the public program.

The public program was at Koogler Wetland/Prairie Reserve, along with 3 group programs. Two monarchs were tagged at the Monarch Waystation and 11 were tagged at Fairborn Marsh. Two of the reared monarchs were released at Koogler at the rescheduled public program, the rest were released at Fairborn Intermediate School. One was tagged at the home of a BCWA member who found a chrysalis on the side of her house after the public program and called when the monarch emerged.
2017	XPY850- XPY949	76	40	36	43	33		154	Tagging took place between 08/26/17 and 10/05/17. The public program was at Koogler Wetland/Prairie Reserve, as was an additional group program. For the first time since the establishment of a Monarch Waystation at Hagenbuch Reserve, more monarchs were tagged there than at Koogler. Of the wild monarchs, 24 were tagged at the Waystation, 13 were tagged at Koogler, 3 at Fairborn Marsh, and 3 at the home of a BCWA trustee. The reared monarchs were released in various locations.
